A casual vacancy is filled by means of a by-election to elect a new member to fill the vacant seat on the council.

Requesting a By-Election

A by-election is only triggered by local government electors requesting a by-election to take place. This request can be made by two local government electors within the Derbyshire Area (not just from the division) giving notice in writing to the proper officer (see details below).

The Holding of a By-Election

Once the requests from the electors are received, the polling day for the by-election must be set at the Deputy Returning Officer's discretion within 35 days of the date of receipt of the requests. There is no time limit for receipt of the requests. If requests are not received, the seat will remain vacant until the next ordinary Elections in 2025.
