- 5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
- Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Civic Offices, Civic Way, Swadlincote, Derbyshire, DE11 0AH by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18th June 2024
- 7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Offices, Civic Way, Swadlincote, Derbyshire, DE11 0AH by 5 pm on **Wednesday, 19th June 2024**.
- 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (insert address) by 5pm on 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
- New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Offices, Civic Way, Swadlincote, Derbyshire, DE11 0AH by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Civic Offices, Civic Way, Swadlincote, Derbyshire, DE11 0AH by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024 and evidence must be provided. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024 and provide evidence to support this.
