Certain information about licences (including in particular your name and the address of any premises to which a licence applies) may be published on a public register on our website when we are required to by law. Licences that have to be determined by our Councillors will be published in minutes on our website.

Guidance:

Guidance note 1: For keeping and training animals for exhibition please provide information about the proposed performance(s) the animals will be exhibited or for which they are trained, including the apparatus which is used for the performance. If it is an animal encounter, please give details of what type of encounter and where they take place. Approximate duration of the performances, number of times the performance will be given on one day, how the animals are transported.

Selling animals as pets: please provide information about the type of business e.g. pet shop, home sales, internet sales, wholesales, third party sales etc.

Hiring out horses: please provide information about the type of business e.g. riding school, trekking, hiring hunters, donkey rides.

Guidance note 2: Please provide information about the animals that will be kept in the licensed area, for example the number and breed of dogs that normally live in the home for a home boarding establishment, the number and breed of dogs that live in a premises used for dog breeding but are not use for breeding, or horses kept for livery that are not using for riding lessons.

Guidance note 3: Please provide details of the accommodation (continue on a separate sheet if required):

Dog and cat boarding (kennel/cattery): number and size of kennels/units, details of kitchen, food storage, isolation facilities, heating, lighting and ventilation and food storage and removal of waste. Home boarding: description and size of rooms that the dogs will be kept in, food storage, information about isolation facilities and removal of waste.

Dog breeding: if the dogs are kept in the home, kennels or a combination. Number and size of kennels, heating, lighting and ventilation and isolation facilities. If the dogs used for breeding are accommodated in the home, a description of the rooms they live in and removal of waste.

Hiring out horses: number of stables, stalls or size of covered yard, details of grazing, tack and food storage and removal and storage of waste.

Selling animals as pets: details of type and size of accommodation, heating (general and requirements for specific animals), lighting (general and requirements for specific animals), filtration (where applicable), details about isolation facilities and removal of waste.

Day care: details of the room(s) available to dogs, including size, heating, lighting and ventilation (where not in a domestic setting), information about isolation facilities and removal of waste.

Keeping or training animals for exhibition: information about the type and size of accommodation, any particular requirements in terms of heating, lighting, filtration, general lighting and ventilation details, isolation facilities and removal of waste.
