


There are a number of administrative and operational benefits to the area specifically conforming with the administrative and electoral area boundaries of the Hatton Parish, as well as more pressing planning issues relating to the area. These are as follows

- The Parish is well defined by the A50 (to the north), the river Dove to the south and to the east and west by the traditional parish boundaries
- Hatton Parish Council has operated for over 100 years and is well established and recognised by residents as the normal unit for local administration and planning matters; it will be easier for parishioners to understand the process and to identify with it.
- The recent changes in parliamentary boundaries which splits Hilton and Hatton from the rest of S Derbyshire, reinforces the need to have clear understandings of boundaries and issues that affect the North West communities of South Derbyshire
- The area conforms with the boundaries for many of the available local statistics and the ongoing SDDC local planning process
- Regular communication is aided by the area selected being covered by Parish Council website and facebook page.
- The Parish Council is keen to work with adjacent neighbouring community of Hilton particularly where proposals might have particular impact on that community.
